Below is a selection of activities for you to choose from related to our topic, *Frozen Kingdom*. Complete one task each week and hand it in in your homework book or via Teams. Homework will be due each Wednesday of term:

Travel Brochure

Create a poster or brochure for a new travel company which arranges visits to the Arctic or Antarctic. Use powerful images and text to tempt customers who want an extra-special trip!

Melting Ice Caps

Research the melting of the polar ice caps. What is causing it? How can we stop it? Why is it a problem? Write a speech or create a poster to raise awareness.



Poem

Write a poem about Shackleton's journey on the *Endurance*. It can follow any structure you would like but should include: similes, metaphors and personification.

You could think about how the crew might have felt at different points in the journey and try to include some of these feelings.

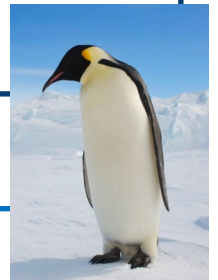

Collage

Use a range of snowy images to create a polar collage. Remember to use lots of interesting textures, shapes, colours and patterns.

Antarctic Meal

Research the kinds of foods which Antarctic expedition members would have eaten. You could draw this as a picture, write a paragraph about it or try and recreate a 3D version.



Inuit Art

Research Inuit art and the processes that this artwork consists of. Can you try and create your own Inuit artwork?



Ice Jewels

Make 'iced jewels'. Mix powder paints and dyes into water, in an array of colours. Pour into an ice cube tray before freezing overnight. Pop the cubes out and explore your iced jewels. What happens if you sprinkle salt on the cubes?

Book Review

Create a book review based on a story/text you have read. This could be a text linked to our topic or simply a book you have read at home! Ask your teacher for some inspiration if you need it.

Snow Boots

Design a pair of snow boots for an Arctic explorer. What materials would you use? What features could they have? Let your imagination run wild!
